

## Installation of GaussView 6 for Mac OS X Systems

- 1. Install Gaussian 16 or the Gaussian Utilities on the system before installing GaussView, following the installation instructions provided.
- 2. Put the DVD into the drive. When the icon appears on the desktop, double click on the icon to open it.
- 3. Double click on the gv-6\_\*-MacOSX\_x86\_64.tbz icon; the full name will include the minor version numbers instead of the asterisk. Archive Utility will be started and the file will be expanded to a folder named gv on either your Desktop or your Downloads folder (if the latter exists).
  - We recommend installing GaussView in the same parent folder as Gaussian 16 or the Gaussian Utilities. After Archive Utility has finished expanding the file, drag the resulting gv folder to the same destination as your g16 folder. For instance, if Gaussian 16 is installed in the Applications folder (i.e., the path is /Applications/g16), then just drag the gv folder to the Applications folder.
- 4. Select the new **gv** folder and then press Command-I to bring up the **Get Info** dialog. Click on the arrow next to **Ownership & Permission**. Then modify the group ownership to the group selected when you installed Gaussian 16 or the Gaussian Utilities.
